## 1. TYPE OF ACTION AND THE REGULATION NUMBER AND NAME:

Amendments to the infectious waste regulatory requirements within 7 DE Admin. Code 1301, Delaware's *Regulations Governing Solid Waste* (DRGSW).

2. PURPOSE OF ACTION:

The Division of Waste and Hazardous Substances (WHS), Compliance and Permitting Section (CAPS) is proposing to modify DRGSW infectious waste regulatory requirements to: reorganize the regulations to improve clarity and applicability for the regulated community, update outdated and obsolete regulatory language, and eliminate contradictions within the permitting requirements for facilities utilizing autoclaves for the treatment of infectious waste.
